**11/2 Update 12:43 pm- NYSEG making progress to out-lying areas, Power outages on Side roads..may continue through Sunday.. awaiting more specifics from NYSEG . If you need assistance Call 331-7000 or of course 911 for Emergencies.**

**11/2 Update 11am - Still some power outages in Woodland Valley above Fawn Hill and in other Hollows around Town. NYSEG expects to have power restored by this afternoon.**

**11/1 Noon UPDATE - There are a few remaining power outages – in some of the outer Hollows, like Upper Birch Creek, parts of Big Indian, and WoodlandValley. NYSEG is working hard and has made these areas their priority for recovery.**

***9:30pm – Herdman Rd, Woodland Valley Rd., Ava Maria Dr. , Lasher Rd., Lost Clove Rd. and Silver Hollow Rd. now closed 'til further notice. Downed Trees and wires. Transformer Fires. Expect Power outages to continue through the night. PLEASE DO NOT drive over or move power lines. Fire, Highway and NYSEG crews are responding as quickly as they can.***

**\*\*\*UPDATE 7pm 10/29/12\*\*\***

***To All Shandaken Residents - State of Emergency continues until further notice. As of 7pm today weather conditions continue to change. The town expects winds to continue gusting until 1:00-2:00 am on Tuesday, October 30th. And due to subside at approximately 6am. Rains will be lighter but persist until 6pm on Tuesday Oct. 30th. Minor flooding may occur. Please remain aware of downed trees, limbs & power lines. Do not drive over or move any downed wires. Downed lines should be reported to NYSEG at 1-800-572-1131. Belleayre Mt. will continue to be available as a shelter until further notice. Road closures at this time: WOODLAND VALLEY ROAD.***

***UC Emergency Services:***

***Model trends are toward an east coast landing Monday or Tuesday. This could be anywhere from New Brunswick to the Chesapeake Bay. However, the official track of the storm by the National Hurricane Center now indicates a possible landfall in New Jersey on Tuesday.***

- If the storm does hit this general area, expect strong gusty winds which will lead to widespread power outages, possible flash flooding and potential river flooding, and even the possibility of snow (although this appears to be an outlier possibility at this time).
- Most areas of the County have received between 3 and 5.5" of rain thus far in October.
- Currently the Ashokan Reservoir is at 77.8% of capacity and the Rondout is at 95.2%.
- There are multiple scenarios! Recall that during Irene a "last minute" change in course had a significant impact on our area.
- It is certainly not too early to "get a kit, make a plan, and stay informed". Have a supply of nonperishable foods and water on hand along with a sufficient quantify of medications, Determine if your home is storm ready - are the gutters cleaned out, tie down or bring in outdoor furniture, etc. Monitor local weather forecasts on this developing situation.
