## Upcoming Town Board Topics & Activity Month OF 1/7/13

**NEW YEAR:** The Town is meeting tonight to re-appoint many of the employees and services necessary to continue the operation of the Town. Please note that due to a personnel matter we will be advertising for a Recycling Coordinator to appoint, more than likely at our February meeting.

Although there are no new issues to be brought up tonight, know that we do know of many issues that will be forthcoming in 2013. First, we do anticipate that this Board will be addressing the Scenic Byway Initiative some time this Spring. We also anticipate the Kiosk Project to continue moving forward hoping to have some of these placed before the onset of the Summer. Although, Eric and I made several attempts at trying to get the New Town Welcome Signs placed, Mother Nature did not cooperate, but as soon as the weather breaks we hope to place the Rte 28 Signs and the Announcement Board outside of Phoenicia, at the very least.

We also anticipate, starting next month, dealing with a number of issues for Flood Mitigation. The SAFARI Group has been working with Tetra Tech on creating a Town specific Flood Mitigation and Emergency Preparedness Plan. Many of the issues will concern new regulations for development within the floodplain, to help make more properties in Town more resilient to flooding. We know that FEMA is due to release new flood map data projected to come in May this year. This data along with the work done by the SAFARI Group may help many residents reduce their flood insurance rates. Accordingly, the Clerk's Office will be sending out a voluntary survey to find more specific information on residents' emergency preparedness knowledge. Please note that all information will be kept in-house and specifically for us to provide better service and response during future emergency situations.

Ambulance: Last month the Town Board advertised and hired a new

Ambulance Billing Service. The Town has chosen ComStar Ambulance Billing Services of Massachusetts. They have provided us with a greatly reduced rate for billing service at

4½%, where we previously were paying 8%, of revenues received. They are also providing the availability of electronic reporting direct from each of the Ambulance vehicles. We are currently in process of procuring a few Tablet computers and hope to have that service running shortly. We hope that this new e-reporting system will provide us with an improved billing system and a quicker return on revenues for the ambulance.

December was rather slow as mother nature waited longer than expected to let the flakes fly, however she has delivered and it is reported that the conditions on the mountain are phenomenal. With attendance to the mountain and other wintery things in the area rising please be careful when out on the roads. In some of the days following snowfall the temperatures have become rather mild, only to again drop significantly at night. This leaves the propensity for icing conditions from melting snowfall and runoff. Please be aware of this while driving and pay particular attention while driving in areas like Plank Road in Phoenicia and County Route 47 in the Oliverea Valley.

Per a request the mileage of Ambulance Department vehicles will be reported in future Ambulance reports in a format much like the Police report. This reporting, in addition to existing electronic fuel logs, existing usage logs in ambulance vehicles, and recorded mileage on Patient Care Reports will assure accurate fuel usage, gauge vehicle replacement, and maintain quality control of the fleet.

The Town of Shandaken Ambulance would like to extend a bit of gratitude to the Town Board whom unanimously approved a transition to a new Ambulance Billing Company and Electronic Reporting System following the long and arduous RFP and review process. This will without a doubt streamline many facets of our operation and save a few trees in the process. #### **RESOLUTION #1-13**

#### **OFFERED BY STANLEY**

#### RULES OF PROCEDURE

**WHEREAS**, §63 of New York State Town law provides that the Town Board may determine the rules of its procedures:

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the following "Rules of Procedure" for regular Town Board meetings be adopted.

The Town Supervisor, as Chairman of the Town Board, shall call meetings of the Town Board to order and shall be the Presiding Officer or Chair of the meeting, and as such shall officiate, maintain order and decorum, and permit public participation in an orderly manner and in accordance with the rules stated below.

- 1. **PLEDGE:** Call to order shall be followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America.
- 2. **ROLL CALL**: The Chair shall request Roll Call of the Town Board members by the Town Clerk, and after determining that a quorum exists, the Town Supervisor shall declare the meeting open. The Town Supervisor shall read the agenda (if not already published and distributed) and proceed to the business of the Town Board at hand.
- 3. **MINUTES:** At each meeting following the new Town Board's January Special Organizational Meeting, the Chair shall provide opportunity for the Town Board to review the minutes of the previous meeting of the Town Board. Thereafter, the Chair shall entertain a motion to approve the minutes as presented or to amend.
- 4. **CORRESPONDENCE:** The Chair shall first call for acknowledgment and summary of any petitions or written communications received by the Town Board. Copies shall be given to the Town Clerk for recording into the minutes.
- 5. **COMMITTEE REPORTS:** The Chair shall recognize committee chairmen for their committees report.
- 6. **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:** The Public will be invited to comment as requested on

items appearing in the published agenda, expressing any views, opinions, requests, recommendations or questions to the Board to address and/or take under advisement in its deliberations. A maximum time limit of 30 minutes. The Public is requested to be brief with their comments.

#### 7. **CONDUCT NEW BUSINESS**

- a. THE SUPERVISOR'S FISCAL REPORT shall be the first order of new business. It shall set forth public monies received through the Town clerk's Office and other sources, and the disbursement of public monies. The Chair shall entertain motions to approve the Supervisor's Fiscal Report and to approve all necessary disbursements of public monies through authorized fund accounts. All actions of the Town Board concerning the Supervisor's Fiscal Report shall be by motion.
- b. RESOLUTIONS: For its deliberations on new matters of Town Business, the Board will work from the written agenda distributed to Board members in advance, posted on the Town bulletin board and distributed at Board meetings to public. Formal actions of the Town Board must be authorized by motion or resolution of the Town Board. No motion or resolution shall be brought to a vote unless it has been presented to all members of the Town Board at least 48 hours prior to the opening of the meeting and on the Town website. In emergency circumstances, however, all of the above requirements may be waived by a vote of a majority of the Town Board present, provided there is a quorum.
- c. Every motion or resolution must be seconded before discussion of the Town Board or the Supervisor calls for a vote. All motions and resolutions shall be recorded in their entirety in the minutes of the Town Board meeting. As a member of the town Board, the Supervisor may offer or second motions and resolutions.
- d. Town Board members must recuse themselves from participation in discussion or voting on matters that involve a conflict of interest and must place in the minutes their reasons for recusal. Abstention from a vote shall only be permitted for reasons of conflict of interest, and not for political considerations.
- 8. **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:** The Board recognizes the value of public participation but reminds the Public that it is a privilege. Please address the Board with respect and civility.
- 9. **ADJOURNMENT:** Following resolutions, and open agenda period, the Town Board meeting shall be adjourned by motion, in memory of residents deceased.

IF THE ABOVE RULES OF PROCEDURE SHOULD AT ANY TIME BE IN CONFLICT WITH STATUTORY LAW, THEN STATUTORY LAW PREVAILS.
