4. Special Topics

- a. Ulster County reports an uptake in visitors this year, surpassing Dutchess County; estimated revenue over \$500 million from visitors.
- b. County wide crash analysis is planned.

5. Noteworthy Zoning Referrals:

a. Rosendale: Zoning Statute Amendment was approved, prohibiting airplanes and helicopters (not including drones) "on, to or from lands and waters within the town, except for military or governmental purposes, or when specifically authorized by the town".

6. On the Horizon:

- a. Accessory residential structures below a certain size may be dropped from the referral requirement—UCPB will send notification if this happens.
- b. County is considering requiring sprinklers for all new construction (!)
