Woodstock HomeShare program

- Recently connected with Janice of <u>HomeShare Woodstock</u> (program of Family of Woodstock)
- Wednesday, October 18 @ 1:30pm there will be an info session at Phoenicia Library
 - Registration is required: call the library or email <u>fstaff@phoenicialibrary.org</u>
- The concept behind HomeShare is to pair homeowners with room in a house/garage/cottage with a renter looking for affordable options and who might also be able to offer task exchange (like transportation, house work, pet care).
- They're expanding their radius to 20 minutes drive out of Woodstock.
- Discussion.

Check in call with Kai from Ulster County -

- Shared our focus on Upzoning and ADU's he agreed
- Shared our trouble completing the STR action due to the specificity of questions 1+2
 - He recommend we complete the action and provide notes/backup as to why we believe it does an adequate job limiting the number of STRs as it's intended to do
 - How are the rules enforced being one of them
 - He noted that currently STRs are 11% of our housing stock
- Invited Kai to the Housing Resource Meet Up
- Discussed how we can host an ADU information session in Shandaken
 - So far they've taken place in Kingston and Saugerties
 - May be an opportunity to bring in zoning board members, as well as residents
- Asked about the <u>PlusOne Home Program</u> (ADU grant) and why it was such a short timeline:
 - He encouraged anyone to apply at this point and they'd be on a short list of interested residents who would be the first to know about future opportunities

- You don't have to had already gone thru all those steps as the application makes it seem
- The more interest the program gets the more likely it is to continue.
- Follow up questions regarding how it affects your tax assessment and tax bill.

 - zoning code was not updated, str law was introduced
 - zoning seems key to increasing density and making what we have work
 - lots of environmental constraints flooding, watershed, park etc
 - lots of focus on route 28, opportunities for accessible housing on public transit lines
 - current population in comparison to predictions?
 - maybe next "homework" is to collect some data about the status of housing in Shandaken
 - o specifies that the town is not looking to increase density "at this time"
 - at what point should that be reassessed
- Do we think it did an adequate job outlining needs?
- What are any usable pieces that we think can still remain?
- How do we incorporate the housing smart community lens and language?

Other thoughts:

- how can people get in touch with us? we are on the website, but maybe we should create a gmail?
- What would it look like to pitch to people with STRs to turn them into long term rentals
- What would it look like to revitalize SHARP?

- its great timing that the town has a housing plan while the comprehensive plan is being written, hopefully this allows us to be far more specific with our recommendations
- How can we help provide upfront capital for individual homeowners to split up their existing property as a multi unit building
