October was an incredibly busy Month for the Ambulance as call volume has increased to above normal levels, and we just completed our two-year Ambulance Service recertification through the New York State Department of Health- which is always an exhaustive process. Due to an ongoing disciplinary issue, and some others moving onto greener pastures, a canvass by employees for Emergency Medical Technicians successfully resulted in the application of four Part-Time EMTs. Expect to see a few new faces around Town learning what we do, and how we do it.

It is the time of year when we start our heating sources for the first time as Winter takes its hold. Please make sure that you have your furnaces, chimneys, and other heating appliances checked and serviced. Every November we see an uptick in carbon monoxide related calls, furnace malfunctions, and even structure fires. Many of these calls can be attributed to a poor service history of heating appliances. Please make a concerted effort to make sure these appliances are working properly- and if you smell gas, or have carbon monoxide alarm activation evacuate and call 911 immediately.

PS- If you haven't already PLEASE test your smoke and CO detectors, and change the batteries. If you need assistance in doing so please contact the Town Clerk's office at 688-5004.

- 2. To enforce the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York to the extent that police officers may be so permitted by the general laws of the State of New York.
- 3. To enforce such Penal Statutes as police officers are permitted to enforce pursuant to the general laws of the State of New York, and in furtherance of said special duties police officers are hereby authorized the use, of a Town Vehicle to be known as a police officer's vehicle which may be equipped with emergency lights in accordance with applicable sections of the Vehicle and Traffic Law, and may use the State and County radio to the extent permitted by the general laws of the State of New York, and may carry fire arms while on duty in compliance with the general laws of the State of New York pertaining to Police Officers generally.
