

# MONTH OF JUNE 2017

PHOENICIA WATER: We are happy to have a resolution to advertise for bids for several projects relating to the Phoenicia Water System. Some of these improvements have been discussed for more than two decades especially the completion of the High Street Loop. This project will provide a secondary crossing for the municipal system on the Woodland Valley Bridge and will provide protections to ensure we can provide continuous potable water service to High Street residences if there is ever another catastrophic failure of the water main on either bridge.

Also included in these projects is installation of a third finishing pump. The filtration plant system currently utilizes two of these pumps that work continuously. This third pump, which was accommodated for in the original design but not installed due to cost overruns, will allow us to relieve some of the workload on the original two pumps, provide longevity to the existing and new pumps, and give us security in case of a failure of any of the pumps.

We will install a Chemical Storage and Ventilation System in order to reduce or eliminate chemical deterioration of the equipment and fumes that are harmful to the equipment and plant operator. We will reclaim the Infiltration Gallery which has become silted up over decades and for a TV inspection of the water tank supplying water to the hamlet.

All of these projects are to be paid through a \$415,000 grant awarded the Town by the NYS Office of Community Renewal. We are awaiting final approval of the Bid Documents from OCR as well as from UC Department of Health. Doing the resolution tonight allows us to go out for bid once those approvals are received, which we anticipate will be some time over the next few weeks, instead of having to wait another five weeks until our next meeting.

**SUMMER RECREATION:** The flyers for the Shandaken Summer Recreation Program are due to go out this week. This year the Program runs from Tuesday, July 11 through Wednesday, August 17. Our Field Trips this year will take the kids to the Bronx Zoo and, as always, Zoom Flume Water Park. We are looking for Summer Recreation Counselors for the six week program and will hire at our next monthly Board meeting. Tonight we have resolutions regarding the operation of the Camp and we wish Rayla and Manny, the Camp Director and Assistant Director, the best with this year's camp.

**SMART GROWTH:** Last year the Town was awarded a near \$30,000 grant from the NYS DEC through their Smart Growth Program. The grant application included several pieces of park equipment that either need replacement, upgrading or new to the parks. There are other facets to this grant that will address over the coming months including landscaping for the Two Town Entrance Signs on Rte 28, signage within each of the parks promoting the Town, and installation of electrical upgrades to Smith Park in Pine Hill. Tonight we will be looking to purchase the following playground equipment: A climbing tunnel or wall for Smith Park, a 3-Hole Disc Golf Course Set for Big Indian Park, Monkey bars for Glenbrook Park, a Spring Jumper

for Parish Field as well as a few picnic tables for Glenbrook and Big Indian Parks. This equipment is estimated to cost approximately \$12,000 from the grant.

**HIGHWAY:** We have a resolution tonight to request bids to replace a Highway Department Pick Up truck that has come to the end of its usefulness. We hope to receive bids and purchase the vehicle within the next month.

MISC.: Additionally, the Bruce Storey Memorial Golf Tournament, formerly the Neil Grant

Tournament, is due to tee off on Monday, June 19<sup>th</sup> at Christman's Golf Course in Windham. This is a
fundraiser that has assisted in paying for local childrens' sporting equipment including Town Programs and
Park Equipment. They are looking for foursomes to join in the fun. For a cost of \$125 per person including 18
holes of Golf, Cart, lunch with beverages on the course, with a Buffet Awards Dinner at the Phoenician
Restaurant at 5pm. If you don't play golf but have a business, you can sponsor a tee for \$50 where a sign will
be placed in the tee box promoting your business. If you're interested in the Bruce Storey Golf Tournament
