RESOLUTION TO ADOPT LOCAL LAW # 3 OF 2025 ENTITLED "A LOCAL LAW TO SUPERSEDE THE WHITEHALL DOCTRINE AND DOCTRINE OF INCOMPATIBILITY WITH RESPECT TO TOWN COUNCILPERSON AND WATER SUPERINTENDENT"

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Shandaken recognizes the need to fill the position of Water Superintendent; and

WHEREAS members of the town board cannot generally hold positions that report to the town board, however the lack of candidates and the retirement of the current water superintendent presented the board with an exigent circumstance, and

WHEREAS the town board passed a resolution hiring Kyle Steen on September 17th as he was the only licensed candidate to apply for an appointment to expire December 31st, and

WHEREAS there are concerns that no additional qualified applicants may be identified ahead of that date for this critical position, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Whitehall doctrine and the doctrine of incompatibility of offices, the Town Board may not appoint one of its own members in the absence of precise statutory authority so to do, and may not make an appointment where an appointee/board member would also be part of his supervising authority (Town Board), without legislative authorization; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has been advised that a Local Law is required supersede the authority preventing a Town Board member from holding the position of Water Superintendent; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Local Law #3 of 2025, has been duly introduced; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the proposed Local Law is a Type II action and can be adopted without further regard to SEQRA; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Shandaken held a Public Hearing on said law on Wed. November 5, 2025,
