**ACCEPT BALLOT PETITION FOR PHOENICIA & MORTON MEMORIAL
LIBRARY BUDGET INCREASES**

WHEREAS, the Shandaken Town Clerk has reviewed and Certified, as correct and accurate, the petition presented by the Phoenicia Library Association & Morton Memorial Library; requesting an increase of the annual contribution of the Town of Shandaken for the operating budgets of the Phoenicia Library & Morton Memorial Libraries, and the Town Board having determined that said petition is sufficient in form and content,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Shandaken requests that the Ulster County Board of Elections place the following proposition on the November 3, 2026 ballot for the Town of Shandaken to be voted “yes” or “no” by the voters of the Town of Shandaken:

YES or NO, **SHALL THE TOWN OF SHANDAKEN INCREASE ITS ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION FOR THE OPERATING BUDGET OF THE MORTON MEMORIAL LIBRARY BY SEVEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED NINETY-EIGHT (\$7,198) DOLLARS TO THE SUM OF EIGHTY-SEVEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE (\$87,173) DOLLARS ANNUALLY; AND SHALL THE TOWN OF SHANDAKEN INCREASE ITS ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION FOR THE OPERATING BUDGET OF THE PHOENICIA LIBRARY BY ELEVEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE (\$11,725) DOLLARS TO THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED FORTY-SIX THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE (\$246,225) DOLLARS ANNUALLY?**
